

Victoria Motor Sports Club Driver Training - *March 28 & 29, 2020*



VMSC invites all drivers to attend this two-day HPDE course. This is a high performance driving school which will benefit anyone who wishes to improve their driving techniques. The course is conducted by our team of qualified, experienced racing drivers. They will take you through a classroom session on day one that will teach you cornering, braking and racing rules. Day two is a full day at the track where one of our experienced team will ride along with you to watch and make suggestions to improve your driving. The track layouts will get progressively faster as your skills improve. The successful student will receive a certificate and is eligible to apply for a Novice Racing license with CACC or ICSCC.

Personal Equipment Requirements:

- Helmet conforming to Snell 2010 or newer
- Wear cotton or wool clothing, underwear and outer wear. This course simulates racing conditions and natural fibers afford the best protection. (No Nylon, polyester or acrylics please)
- Goggles, face shields or helmet visors required in open cars
- Flexible leather shoes with low or no heels are best

Car Requirements:

- The car will need to pass a technical inspection that includes the brakes, steering, suspension and electrical components. They must all be in excellent condition.
- Seatbelts for driver and passenger conforming to Transport Canada MVSR 2019 or SFI 16.1, in two-seat cars.
- Competition roll bar in open cars will need to meet club requirements at tech inspection
